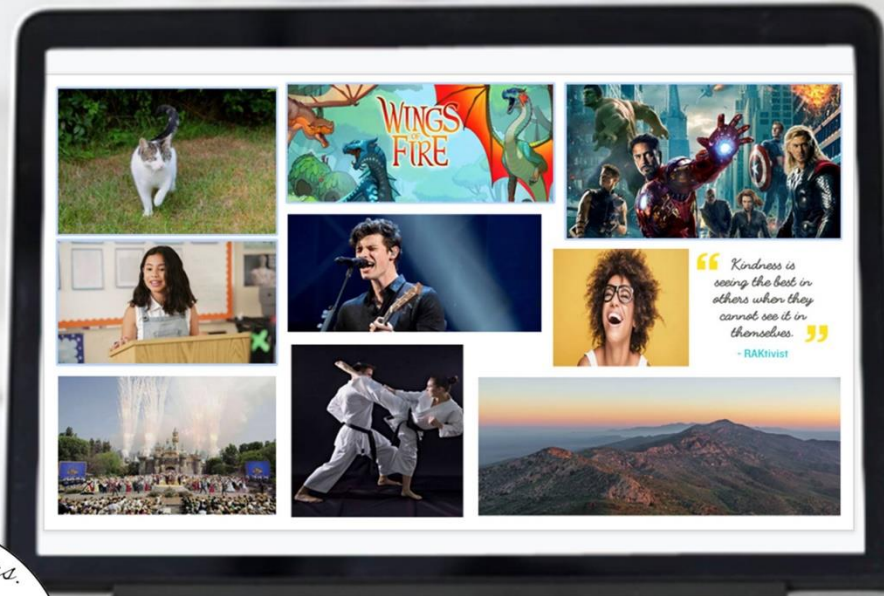

WORK DUE: Hyperlink Image Collage Google Slide
POINTS: /10 GRADED FOR or SKILLS/TASKS TO COMPLETE: 10 Images each with a hyperlink connected.
TEACHER NOTES: As mentioned in the description of this product, you should have the previous lesson that prepares students for the understanding of hyperlinks and hypertexts. It is however very possible to use this lesson without the previous "Hypertext: All About Me!" I have found students really do enjoy this activity because they get to research things they are interested in and get to share it.
