| GRADES: 4-8 | LENGTH: 1 Class Period |
| OBJECTIVE: Students will create a stick figure GIF file using key-frames with the Online Figure Animator! | |
| DIRECTIONS: 1. Click on the link below to access the online animator. 2. Begin by clicking the stick-figure found on the left to add to your canvas, (the white backdrop/work-space). 3. Set your person in your starting position and be ready to click "Add new frame" at the bottom. 4. Add another custom object by clicking the orange "blank" circle. This will add a point/joint you will be able to manipulate with later. 5. [Redacted] 6. CREATING YOUR GIF / SAVING: When finished, click the picture icon found at the top, "Export animation as gif" 7. You may want to click "Bookmark" to save your website URL to view later or show. As mentioned in the video, this is the ONLY online stick figure editor that does not require an extension, app, or download to use. I like to use this lesson as a "one and done" lesson in my animation unit as it is just enough to expose students to the concept and offer some pretty good, but basic tools starting out with this type of animation. However, this may catch an interest in some students where they will want to go deeper and use a more robust application. |
